

Moses:

- 10 Commandments...Exodus 20
- - Law of Moses...Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy
- - Structured Jewish society through the time of Christ and after
- - Differed from other civilizations' laws because it dealt with relationships: between God and man; man and his neighbor; man and himself
- - Significant because breaking the law has communal and salvific effects.

Jesus:

- Came to fulfill the law
- - Law of Moses made more personal and sanctified
- - Beatitudes – Gospel of Matthew is solid basis for Jesus' teachings
- - Emphasizes relationship between God and man; man and neighbor

Paul:

- Manifest/prioritizes the teachings of Christ
- - Developed in Epistles of Paul
- - Emphasizes more relationship for one another as the Body of Christ
- - Unity becomes a part of morality
- - Love as an essential element of morality
- - Morality must extend from us to others...it needs to be given away.

Augustine:

- "Our hearts are restless until they rest in you O, Lord"
