

**TEMPE SCHOOLS CREDIT UNION LOAN PROGRAM
BULLETIN ANNOUNCEMENT**

The Tempe Schools Credit Union Tuition Assistance Loan Program is being offered again this year to ensure everyone who pays Arizona State Income Tax is able to contribute to support our St. John Vianney School. We currently have 21 parish families using this program – let's get at least 15 more this year.

Remember – it costs you nothing to contribute part of your taxes to the St. John Vianney School. You can either pay your taxes to the State of Arizona or you can give your tax money to help provide tuition assistance to deserving children so they can attend St. John Vianney School.

When you use the loan program, the Credit Union contributes the money for you and you repay the loan from your tax refund without interest provided you repay your loan before May 31, 2008. With this loan program there is absolutely no reason not to contribute part of the taxes to St. John Vianney School that you will otherwise pay to the State of Arizona.

Information and forms are available at the school office. Current Credit Union members can mail in the required forms themselves. New members must leave the forms with a \$25 membership fee (which is deposited in your account) with the office before December 14, 2007. New membership applications and other forms will be delivered to the credit union on December 14, 2007.
